PEER COURT & CASE CONFERENCING

Peer Court took place in Anderson this month, giving students the chance to take leadership in restorative justice by serving as jurors, advocates, and peer mentors. Through these sessions, youth learn accountability, empathy, and the power of repair.

Behind the scenes, our staff and peer advocates worked together in Case Conferencing, collaborating with probation, schools, and families to ensure each student receives individualized support and resources for success.

SAFETY FIRST & AGGRESSION REPLACEMENT TRAINING (A.R.T.)

Both our Safety First prevention classes and A.R.T. cohorts for guys and girls continued strong this month. These programs equip youth with real-life tools for emotional regulation, decision-making, and communication—skills that build resilience long after class ends.

Youth consistently share that these sessions help them recognize their choices, manage stress, and build confidence in positive problem-solving.

Social Media Mentorship Team Launches

October marked the official launch of our Youth Action Council (YAC) Social Media Team — a creative mentoring opportunity designed to help students grow in both skill and purpose. Each month, YAC members will learn to share the heart and impact of Youth Options Shasta through photos, videos, and written content that reflects our mission and the stories unfolding in our programs.



This new initiative gives students space to develop their creativity and confidence while learning leadership, communication, and collaboration. Through weekly mentoring check-ins, they're learning how to write and create in a way that reflects the voice, values, and vision of Youth Options Shasta — bringing authenticity and purpose to every post.

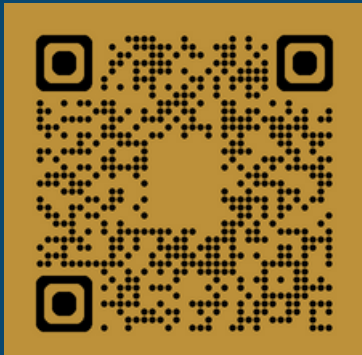
